ABOUT THE SYNERGY NETWORK

Background

It is becoming evident that efforts to tackle serious violence amongst young people have been hindered by a lack of a joined-up approach in many community organisations.

With this in mind, Ascension Trust was awarded a grant from Jerusalem Trust to commission several key agencies in Lambeth and Newham to work together with a collaborative approach to the key contributing factors of violence; families, gang, teen pressure and education.

The Hope Partnership was launched at an event held at Clapham Methodist church on 4th May 2017. This partnership consists of four organizations who are working together to tackle serious violence in the areas of gangs, peer-pressure, education and family. The four organizations are CHIPS, New Choices for Youth, Spark2Life and Cassandra Learning Centre.

The Ascension Trust Synergy Network

The HOPE 2017 event, which showcased this partnership, was a success with representatives from approximately one hundred organizations coming out to learn about the model of collaboration that was being presented. Going forward, many of the attendees expressed interest in staying connected with the network in some shape or form. This interest is the incentive behind the creation of the **'Ascension Trust Synergy Network'** which would consist of a wide network of organizations 'buying into' the concept of collaboration and partnership expressed at HOPE 2017.

The Synergy Network and Collaboration

An integral part of the HOPE 2017 event was networking. Networking allows organizations to increase their awareness of others engaged in similar work; to share expertise and knowledge and to improve their effectiveness by working to shared strengths.




Fig. 1 Collaborative partnership within the Synergy Network

Ascension Trust Positioned to Deliver Training in Collaboration

Over the past twenty four years, Ascension Trust has been engaged in activities to tackle gangs, guns and anti-social behaviour. The 'Guns Off Our Streets' Roadshow, in 1993, had a significant impact upon communities as it birthed the now well established Street Pastor initiative. Today there are over 270 Street Pastor initiatives operating nationally and internationally.

It is therefore at the fore front of work which requires partnership, collaboration and how to effectively mobilise volunteers to impact the community in regards to issues on our street. To achieve this end, partnership with the Urban Trinity, (the police, faith community and local councils), is effective and securely established. The task of effectively administering so many schemes both across the country and abroad requires a high level of competence in governance. Recognition of this organisations success has been acknowledged in the form of awards and accolades.

Ascension Trust, with its experience of putting together partnerships, networks and collaborating with organizations, is in a good position to deliver training and advice to organizations and individuals who want to increase their effectiveness and partner with others. This will include advice on funding, governance and legislation.
