Day 6:

On the Streets

Street Pastors (day and evening patrols), Rail Pastors - These groups form several hundred patrols over the 250+ Street Pastors initiatives across the country. Most Street Pastors can testify to God's presence with them during their time on the streets. God's love and involvement and protection in this vital work are never taken for granted.

Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity. Col. 4: 5 (NLT)

- Pray for patrols going out wisdom, safety, discernment, peace, divine appointments and faith conversations
- Ask God to help them embrace and respond creatively to local change, being open to new opportunities
- Commit to God the prayer support for the patrols, through Prayer Pastors
 Prayer Partners, as well as prayer on the streets
- Pray for some of the specific needs of people encountered in your own locality
